Board of Health OWTS Discussion

Commissioner Kibel opened as the Board of Health.

County Septic Inspector Jeff Carhart shared details in regards to a septic complaint of waste surfacing due to a possible failed system. Thomas and Forth Engineering designed the system in question in 2007. The waste was not present at a site visit last week. Several one-bedroom cabins, a RV park and the Groundhog Store all tie into several systems in the design. New Regulation 43 Septic Standards now require as built drawings and one is needed to understand the system in place to begin to address the situation. The County will GPS the cabins, RV park and Store location to create an accurate site plan. Then County will then request an as-built overlay from the permit holder, to determine what septic systems are in place for each structure. A soil sample may be taken to determine if waste is present in the area reported.
