Forest Service Road 521 Discussion

Dolores County Landowner Gayel Alexander was present to request assistance with maintenance on Forest Service Road 521. Ms. Alexander owns a cattle permit in Dolores County. Road conditions are deplorable causing significant damage to vehicles and equipment. The County has a contract with the Forest Service to provide maintenance on roads twice a year. More frequent and better maintenance is needed to improve road conditions. After a lengthy discussion the Board offered to set up a meeting with the Forest Service and Ms. Alexander.

Executive Session to Receive Legal Advice

There was no executive session.

New Business

A recent request had been made to the Road and Bridge Department for the installation of 4 cattle guards on County roads. Neighboring counties were contacted and their procedures and policies were reviewed. The cost of materials for construction, installation and maintenance of cattleguards were discussed. The effects to neighboring land owners and livestock on County Roads was also touched on. The BOCC decided that some basic parameters needed to be put in place. Attorney Golbricht will draft a policy in regards to cattleguards. The Board will review requests on a case by case basis until such a policy can be adopted.

Old Business

Bruin Waste was again mentioned as an option for providing recycling at transfer station. Information has been being gathered, with more still needed. Budget season is fast approaching and final costs are a concern to make the possible change to Bruin.

Meetings and Information

Commissioner Kibel gave an update on STUD.

Commissioner Garchar adjourned the meeting.
